
# TMA Expands Health Promotion Impact with 2018 Grants

Cancer, diabetes and obesity are among the health issues that TMA's 2018 health improvement initiatives are tackling thanks to \$576,163 in grants approved by the TMA Foundation Board of Trustees.

New in 2018 will be a HPV Social Media Campaign, which aims to increase awareness of the importance of human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination to reduce the risk of certain cancers. The social media strategies will target older teens/young adults in small- to medium-sized college towns with lower than-average HPV vaccination rates. The campaign supports the public education component of TMA's HPV Working Group and TMA's Council on Health Promotion.

TMA's signature community outreach programs (Hard Hats for Little Heads, Be Wise — Immunize<sup>SM</sup> and Walk with a Doc Texas) all received funding, as well as the TMA Minority Scholarship Program, the expanded TMA Ernest and Sarah Butler Awards for Excellence in Science Teaching and University of Health. Texans in six communities will be protected from the flu, receive donated specialty care, be screened for Hepatitis C and more thanks to grants recently approved by the TMA Foundation Board of Trustees.

# **2** Immunization Project/Tarrant County Medical Society Alliance Foundation (TCMSAF)

The TCMSAF provides funding, volunteers, and leadership to the The Immunization Collaboration of Tarrant County which annually serves more than 7,000 children with 20,000 doses of vaccine and distributes nearly 20,000 pieces of education materials.

The Lamar-Delta County Medical Society is partnering with the Paris-Lamar County Health District and other community groups to offer a "drive-thru" influenza shot clinic to protect 400 citizens, age 18 and older.
